重要提示

(1) 本软件仅限教育机构在获得合法授权（包括但不限于校规、家长同意书、学生知情同意等法律认可形式）的前提下，于课堂教学设备上使用。

(2) 本软件作为通用技术工具，本身不具备违法属性。其合法性完全取决于使用者的具体场景和授权状态。开发团队仅提供技术实现，不对使用者的具体应用行为（如是否获得家长同意、是否符合校规）承担任何审查义务或连带责任。

(GPL-3.0) 开源协议发布。本协议为 GPL-3.0 的补充约定，仅限于规范商标使用、增值服务及合规指引。与本协议冲突之处，以 GPL-3.0 为准；本协议未约定事项，适用 GPL-3.0 的规定。

第一条 定义与知识产权

1.1 软件定义

本协议所称“软件”包括 ClassScreenLock 的全部程序文件、源代码、目标代码、内置文档、图标、音频素材、界面设计、后续更新版本及衍生作品。

1.2 知识产权归属

1.2.1 本软件原始版本的著作权、商标权及其他知识产权归开发团队所有。

1.2.2 您对衍生作品享有著作权，但必须依照 GPL-3.0 进行许可，不得附加任何额外限制。

1.2.3 “ClassScreenLock” 文字标识及开发团队官方 LOGO

（以下简称“商标”）是开发团队的商标，独立于 GPL-3.0 许可。本协议不限制您依据 GPL-3.0 对包含商标的软件界面或图标进行修改与分发，但您不得将商标作为独立标识用于指示软件来源之外的任何商业用途，亦不得以可能引起混淆的方式使用商标。任何对商标的使用均须遵守商标法，不因软件采用 GPL-3.0 许可而视为自动授权。

第二条 许可与限制

2.1 GPL-3.0 许可

开发团队依据 GPL-3.0 向您授予使用、复制、修改、分发本软件的权利。您行使上述权利时，必须遵守 GPL-3.0 的全部条款。

2.2 分发义务

您以二进制形式分发本软件（无论原版或修改版）时，必须同时提供完整的、机器可读的对应源代码。您不得要求接收者支付额外费用以获取源代码，但可以为分发二进制文件本身收取合理费用。

2.3 权利保留

本协议未明确授予您的任何权利，均由开发团队保留。

第三条 违规与终止

3.1 授权终止

任何违反 GPL-3.0 的行为，将导致您依据本协议和 GPL-3.0 获得的授权立即自动终止。若您在首次违反后 30 日内完全纠正违规行为，且此前无其他违规记录，则授权可依 GPL-3.0 第 8 条规定自动恢复。

3.2 终止后果

授权终止期间，您对本软件的任何复制、修改、分发行为均构成对开发团队著作权的侵犯。授权恢复后，您可继续行使 GPL-3.0 授予的权利。

3.3 开发团队权利

开发团队有权对任何违反 GPL-3.0 或本协议的行为采取以下措施：

- (1) 发出警告，要求停止侵权、公开源代码或下架侵权产品；
- (2) 向代码托管平台、应用商店及电商平台提交侵权投诉；
- (3) 提起诉讼，要求赔偿损失；
- (4) 对于确凿的恶意违反行为，开发团队将采取严厉打击措施。

3.4 恶意干扰行为的禁止与法律追诉

(1) 行为界定与权利边界：本软件遵循 GPL-3.0 协议。开发团队明确承认并尊重用户依据 GPL-3.0 及操作系统规范享有的合法权利，包括但不限于使用系统标准功能管理进程，以及为了学习、研究、安全测试而对本软件进行逆向分析、修改或编写测试脚本的行为。开发团队对此类合法行使权利的行为不予禁止，并秉持开放精神，鼓励相关研究成果以开源形式共享，以促进技术透明与安全生态的建设。

然而，任何个人或组织若开发、分发、销售或使用专门的第三方程序、脚本、工具，且其实质功能或主要用途符合以下任一情形的，将被视为恶意干扰行为：

一、商业牟利：通过破坏本软件功能来出售“破解版”、“免控版”或提供付费绕过服务；

二、恶意破坏：旨在恶意阻碍本软件为合法授权用户提供正常服务，或开发专门用于终止、屏蔽、干扰本软件进程、守护进程、集控通信及阻碍软件运行的工具；

三、非法协助：明知使用者未获合法授权，仍专门提供工具协助其逃避监管；

特别提示：凡以商业牟利或恶意针对为目的实施上述行为，或向已知正在利用本软件从事违反本协议活动（如攻击、破解、非法牟利）的个人或组织提供技术支持、工具分发的，均可据此认定行为人具有“恶意”意图及“明知”状态。若行为人主张其行为不具有恶意或不明知，应提供相应证据予以说明。

（2）用户违规后果：若教育机构或终端用户主动使用上述界定的“恶意干扰工具”破坏本软件运行，视为违反本协议第五条“用户责任”中的合规义务。开发团队有权终止

对该特定用户的服务支持，并在官方网站公示其违规行为。

(3) 对第三方的法律追诉：对于开发、分发上述恶意工具的第三方（无论是否为本软件用户），其行为已超出 GPL-3.0 许可范畴，涉嫌违反《中华人民共和国反不正当竞争法》第十三条（互联网不正当竞争行为）及《网络反不正当竞争暂行规定》。若造成严重后果，可能触犯《中华人民共和国刑法》第二百八十六条。开发团队保留对此类恶意干扰行为的实施者、分发者采取向行政主管部门举报、向公安机关报案、提起民事诉讼等一切法律行动的权利，并要求其赔偿由此产生的一切损失（包括但不限于商誉损失、维权成本）。

第四条 系统要求与预期限制说明

4.1 运行环境

本软件支持 Microsoft Windows 10/11 64 位操作系统，需安装 .NET 9.0 Runtime 及以上版本。以及需要有 400MB

的运行空间和 1500MB 的存储空间。本软件的安装及核心管控功能需以管理员身份运行。

4.2 预期限制与风险

4.2.1 管理员权限与自我保护：本软件基于 Windows 标准接口运行。若设备使用者拥有管理员权限，依据 GPL-3.0 赋予的权利，其完全有能力通过系统工具终止、修改或绕过本软件。这是开源软件的特性而非漏洞。看门狗机制仅用于防止意外崩溃，无法也不应阻止拥有系统最高权限的用户行使对自己设备的控制权。

4.2.2 非稳定版本提示：V1.12.26.2637 及同系列早期版本属于非稳定构建版（Beta）。新引入的守护进程和 Web 集控功能涉及系统底层权限及网络通信，可能存在进程崩溃、连接失败或数据异常等风险。开发团队强烈建议您在虚拟环境或非生产环境中先行测试。

4.2.3 网络依赖：Web 集控功能的可用性依赖于客户端与 Web 服务器之间的网络连通性。若无网络连接或无集控需

求，客户端的单机功能不受影响。

4.2.4 浏览器兼容性：Web 管理后台建议在 Chromium

130+ 版本内核的浏览器中运行，不兼容 Internet

Explorer。

4.2.5 数据防护限制：数据防篡改与备份系统旨在增强配

置数据的稳定性，但不能保证在极端情况（如存储介质物

理损坏）下数据的绝对完整。

4.2.6 技术保护措施合法性声明：为保障软件正常服务

功能及使用环境的稳定性，本软件包含的进程守护、异常

自动重启、软件运行数据完整性校验等技术措施，属于正

当的自我保护行为，不构成对用户权利的非法限制。依据

中国相关法律法规，破坏此类正当技术保护措施的行为不

受法律保护。

第五条 用户责任与合规指引

5.1 使用合规

您应确保对软件的使用符合所有适用法律法规。因您使用软件产生的法律责任，由您自行承担。

5.2 高风险功能

本软件包含摄像头拍摄、屏幕截图、网络拦截、远程配置同步等功能。您启用上述功能前，应依法获得必要授权，并采取合理措施保护数据安全。因未获授权使用上述功能产生的法律责任，由您独立承担。

5.3 数据安全

软件运行产生的所有数据均存储在您的本地设备（客户端）或您自行部署的服务器（Web 集控平台）上。开发团队不会主动收集、上传任何数据。您对数据的备份、安全及合法处理负全部责任。

5.4 部署与运维责任

若您选择部署和使用 Web 集控管理平台，您应先在虚拟环境进行测试，并自行承担服务器的安全配置、端口放行、访问控制、数据备份及密码管理（特别是首次登录后立即更改默认密码）之责任。因服务器部署不当、配置泄露或第三方攻击导致的一切后果，由您自行承担。

第六条 数据与隐私保护

6.1 数据收集范围

本软件（客户端）及其可选组件（Web 集控平台）不主动向开发团队收集、上传任何个人数据。软件运行过程中产生的管控日志、拍摄影像、屏幕截图、配置文件等所有数据，均仅存储在您指定的本地设备或您自有的服务器中，开发团队无法获取、访问这些数据。

6.2 网络拦截功能特别说明

本软件的网络拦截功能仅记录访问的域名，不记录完整 URL 参数，不记录页面内容，不存储通信载荷。

6.3 屏幕截图功能特别说明

本软件的屏幕截图功能为定期截屏，截图文件仅存储于本地。启用该功能时，软件可通过日志查询截图时间点，以保障被记录者的知情权。

6.4 集控功能特别说明

使用 Web 集控功能时，客户端的状态信息、设备标识及用于策略同步的配置数据，将传输至您自建的 Web 服务器进行处理。这些数据的存储与安全由您全权负责。

6.5 用户责任

您应对数据的存储、备份、安全保护及合法处理负全部责任。因设备故障、操作不当、病毒攻击、第三方行为等导致的数据丢失、泄露，开发团队不承担任何责任。

第七条 免责声明

7.1 软件按现状提供

本软件按“现状”提供，开发团队不提供任何明示或暗示

的担保，包括但不限于适销性、特定用途适用性、无错误、不中断的担保。对于标记为“非稳定版本”的构建，其潜在风险更高，您需自行评估并承担测试和使用风险。

7.2 责任限制

在适用法律允许的最大范围内，开发团队不对任何因使用或无法使用本软件导致的损失承担责任，包括但不限于数据丢失、设备损坏、业务中断。本条款不适用于依法无法排除或限制的责任（包括但不限于因开发团队故意或重大过失、产品缺陷导致的严重损害责任）。

7.3 第三方组件

本软件使用的第三方开源组件由其各自权利人按相应许可提供，开发团队不对其承担保证责任。详细请看附件 2。

第八条 法律适用与争议解决

8.1 法律适用

本协议的订立、效力、解释、履行及争议解决均适用中华人民共和国法律。

9.2 若您不同意修改后的协议，应立即停止使用并卸载软件。

第十条 其他

10.1 本协议构成双方关于软件使用的完整协议。

10.2 若本协议任何条款被认定为无效或不可执行，不影响

其余条款的效力。

10.3 开发团队未行使本协议中的任何权利，不视为对该权利的放弃。

Preamble

The GNU General Public License is a free, copyleft license for software and other kinds of works.

The licenses for most software and other practical works are designed to take away your freedom to share and change the works. By contrast, the GNU General Public License is intended to guarantee your freedom to share and change all versions of a program--to make sure it remains free software for all its users. We, the Free Software Foundation, use the GNU General Public License for most of our software; it applies also to any other work released this way by its authors.
